First Regional Workshop to be Held in Madison

As we shared with you a few months ago, ADI-WI is planning regional workshops in an effort to continue providing professional development opportunities in a more cost-effective manner.

Our first regional workshop is planned for Saturday, November 6 in Madison. After much consideration, the Board decided to focus on Direct Instruction and Response to Intervention (RtI). Two of our Board members, SuAnn Pagel-Rast and Tami McGrattan, have been working hard to develop and compile materials for the four-hour workshop.

SuAnn Pagel-Rast will be the featured presenter at our first workshop. SuAnn has over 30 years of teaching experiences and has been using DI materials for 30 years. Currently she is a K-5 cross-categorical special educator in the Almond-Bancroft schools.

During the DI and RtI workshop, we will provide a brief review of the basic tenets of Response to Intervention, as well as a brief overview of the lesson design of Direct Instruction and how it fits into RtI. The DI and RtI overviews will be followed by opportunities for partici-

pants to construct interventions from existing programs and additional resource materials.

SuAnn is encouraging participants to bring their own instructional materials and instructional challenges. While ADI-WI and SuAnn are providing some materials, you may find your time and energies are well spent working with materials currently being used in your classrooms.
